EQUITATION FINALS

The H&H Tack Shop and Josey Mohler Equitation Finals will be held at the CPJHSA Benefit Horse Show this year. Riders will be notified in writing that they have qualified to enter. To qualify, a rider must have won 2 ribbons, from first to sixth place, during the qualifying period of September 15, 2007 through September 1, 2008. Riders must have been a member of CPJHSA at the time the ribbons were won and must be a current member by the closing date of entries for the designated horse show.
