Presidents Report- Candi opened the meeting with some welcoming remarks and indicated it was a very successful year for CPJHSA. A motion to approve the 2018 annual minutes was made by Maureen, seconded by Abbie and the minutes are approved from annual meeting.

Treasurer's Report- We are looking at September because we did not meet in October. This is what we present to the membership at large. Motion by Donna and second by Margie and the report is adopted.

Awards- Amanda reported that she is under budget.

Scholarship/sportsmanship- This year, we had 4 applicants. Had nice thank you letters from each of the winners and had three good candidates for the sportsmanship award. July 1 is the application deadline.

Rules- A discussion that someone brought up was aligning Josey with Gittings but let the rules committee decide.

Ways and Means- Maureen presented. The committee raised over 10K which is the highest we have ever raised. Thank you letters have been sent out.

Benefit Show- 2018 the show had a historic year. We doubled the profit amount budgeted - raised over 21K.
