5. Indicate any other information concerning family and finances that affect your need for scholarship aid.
6. Describe your past and current involvement with horses, not limited to horse ownership and competition, and state what that involvement has meant to you.
7. Explain why you feel you should be the recipient of the CPJHSA Scholarship and/or how this scholarship will help you.

Enclose a copy of your college acceptance letter, final student transcript of your high school grades, a letter of recommendation from a non-family CPJHSA member and a second letter of recommendation from a school official. Your application will be weight as follows:

- 35% - Scholarship
- 45% - Equine Involvement
- 10% - Presentation
- 5% - Extracurricular Activity
- 5% - Need

Applications should be received by July 1st. **All transcripts and reference letters should be mailed directly to the CPJHSA Secretary. It is the applicant's responsibility to assure all documents have been received.** Scholarships are awarded at the CPJHSA Annual Awards Banquet typically held in November of each year. You need not be present at the banquet to receive a scholarship.
