

CPJHSA LOCAL PROGRAM

All courses must have at least seven jumps and should be appropriate for the level of competition. Management may adjust up to the fence height as needed, and oxers and combinations are discouraged for any class below 2'6". Sections may be split or combined at management's discretion.

Leadline - Open to riders 8 years of age and under.

Walk Trot Eq/Hunter- Open to riders 13 years and under not showing in any class where fences exceed 18". To be judged on manners, performance, suitability of rider and soundness 50% and equitation of rider 50%.

Walk-Trot-Canter- Open to junior riders not showing in any class where fences exceed 2'6". To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring and judged on horsemanship only.

Pleasure Hunter Horse/Pony -To be judged on mount's suitability to give a pleasurable ride. Fences 18". Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into any classes jumping higher than 2'.

Short/Long Stirrup Equitation - Open to junior and adult riders. To be judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider 50% and equitation of rider 50%. Fences 18".

Easy Does It/Hopeful Hunter – Open to horses or ponies ridden by juniors, adults (ponies may be ridden by adults). To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 18" and will include a change of direction. Trot or canter fences. Trotting in corners is not to be penalized.

Modified/Training/Baby Hunter - Open to all riders. To be judged on manners, suitability and soundness. Fences 2' for ponies, 2'3" for horses. No oxers, trotting in corners is not to be penalized.

Low Hunter - Open to all riders. To be judged on manners, suitability and soundness. Fences 2', 2'6", and 2'9".

Pre-Child/Adult Hunter – Open to horses or ponies. Ponies may only be ridden by a junior, horses may be ridden by a junior or adult. To be judged on manners, suitability and soundness. Fences 2' for ponies, 2'6" for horses. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into Child/Adult Hunter.

Child/Adult Hunter - Open to ponies or horses. Ponies may only be ridden by a junior, horses may be ridden by a junior or adult. To be judged on manners, suitability and soundness. Fences 2' Small/Medium, 2'6" Large, 3' for horses.

Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into the Pre- Child/Pre- Adult division.

Performance Hunter - Open to all. To be judged on manners, suitability and soundness. Fences 3'3".

Thoroughbred Hunters- (2' or 2'6)- Open to all riders and Thoroughbreds with T.I.P. numbers or proof of registration with the Jockey club.(Number can be obtained for free on www.tjctip.com). Judged on soundness, manners, way of going and suitability.

Jumper Specs

Novice Jumper – Up to 1.0m - Open to horses and ponies.

Intermediate Jumper 1.05m-1.2m - Open to horses and ponies.
